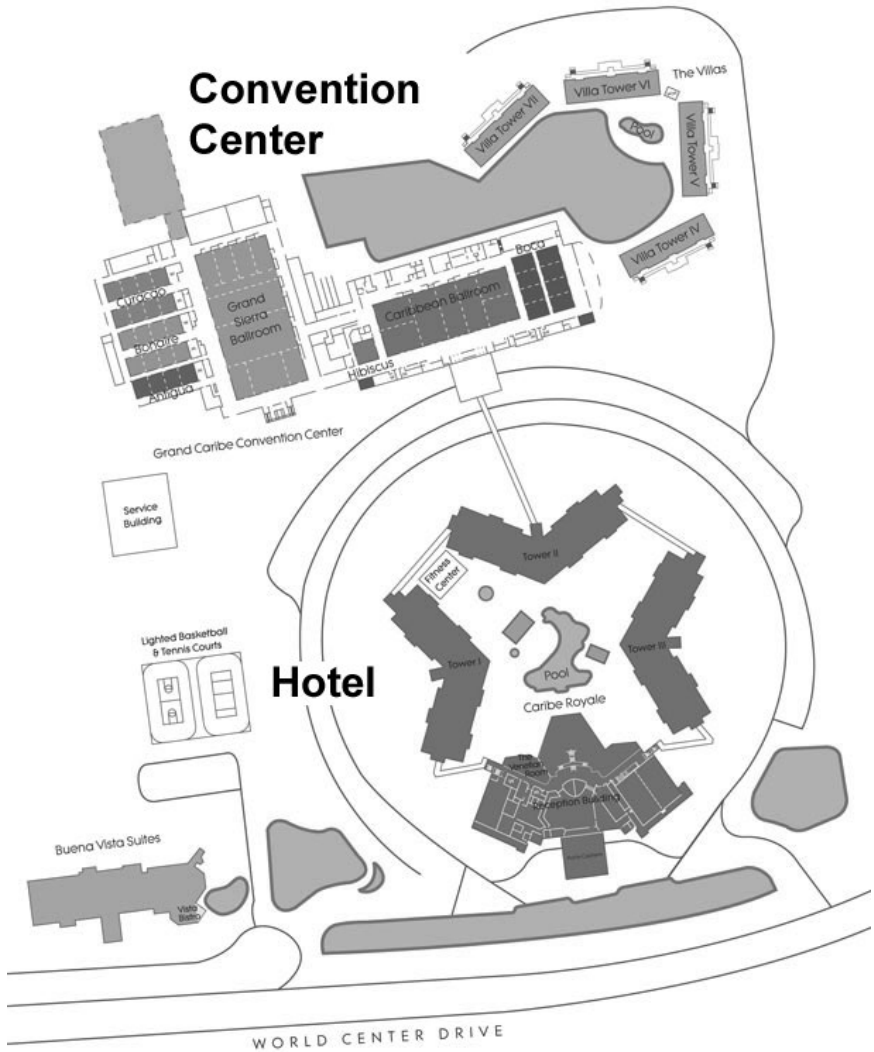
For AETA Certification purposes, there will be 10 CE credits for the 2017 AETA & CETA/ACTE Joint Convention.
