



AETA Annual Convention Student Scholarship Award

The American Embryo Transfer Association is offering up to ten (10) Student Scholarship Awards to help cover expenses at the 2017 AETA & CETA/ACTE Joint Annual Meeting in Orlando, Florida, from October 26 to October 28, 2017. The scholarship covers student registration, preconvention seminar(s), preconference sessions, Friday and Saturday scientific sessions, banquet, breakfasts, lunches, breaks, maximum hotel accommodations for three (3) nights, round trip airfare for one, and entrance to the preconference social.

STIPEND APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

1. All applicants must be currently enrolled in an accredited university or program and be interested in pursuing a career in embryo transfer.
2. If not already a member, applicant must become a student member of AETA, which is now **FREE!**
3. Must agree to attend scientific sessions, business meeting, banquet, breakfast, luncheons, breaks, and preconference social.
4. Must agree to submit a report and post-meeting evaluation of the Annual Meeting, stating objectives for meeting attendance, what was gained from attendance, and how this knowledge can be put to use in the industry and your academic work. Additionally, this report will be published in the fall edition of the AETA newsletter, *A Closer Look*. This report must be written and submitted to the AETA Headquarters within 30 days following the meeting.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Complete the AETA Annual Convention Student Scholarship Application.
2. Prepare a 500-word written statement on the following topic: **Why should the American Embryo Transfer Association send me to the 2017 Annual Meeting?**
3. Essays listing what you will do at the event will not be considered. Rather, the essay must incorporate the meeting curriculum and demonstrate the anticipated benefits.
4. Include two (2) letters of recommendation from either a faculty advisor and/or a current AETA member.
5. Submit the documents and completed application, to the email address listed below or by ground mail postmarked no later than August 27, 2017, to:
